## 1. Welcome and apologies for absence.

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and thanked members of the public for attending. No apologies for absence were received.

## 2. To receive declarations of interest.

There were none declared.

## 3. Open Forum: an opportunity to hear from members of the public.

The Chairman spoke to the issue initially before asking for comments from members of the public. He set out the issue in that a large area of Harpers Green had been cleared without authority from the Parish Council and this was an issue, not only because of the loss of valuable habitat, but from a financial point of view in that the area concerned is part of the Higher Level Stewardship Scheme. The schemes management plan sets out that, apart from a green area in the centre, this area should be left alone. If the plan is not adhered to then the Parish Council could be asked to repay some of the grant funding.

The Chairman then apologised to the resident to whom a letter had been sent instructing them to cease all works and had since said they were not responsible for the damage.

The members of the public who had carried out the works said they had done so with, what they thought, was permission but are now aware of the procedure to be followed.

Some interesting points were also covered including hedge trimming along Harpers Lane, the rubbish collected in the clearance work and ownership of the ditches at Harpers.

The Chairman proposed that the matter be closed as the parties that carried out the work will follow Council procedures in the future, this was seconded by Cllr Diggens and unanimously agreed by Council.
